Summer in the North Georgia mountains brings long sunny days, cool river breezes, and endless ways to enjoy the outdoors. Kayakers and tubers drift along refreshing mountain rivers while hikers and bikers explore scenic trails beneath deep green forests and bright blue skies. Afternoons are perfect for browsing downtown shops, relaxing on restaurant patios, or enjoying a scoop of ice cream after a day of adventure. As the sun sets, the mountains come alive with live music, fireflies, and evenings best spent around a cabin deck or lakeside firepit.

FOOD, FUN *and* MORE!

Summer is also packed with festivals, concerts, and community events across the region. **Blue Ridge Community Theater** keeps audiences entertained throughout the season with productions like *Mama Won't Fly*, running

July 16 through August 2. Meanwhile over in Hiawassee, **Georgia Mountain Fairgrounds** hosts summer concerts, Fourth of July fireworks, and the annual Georgia Mountain Fair August 14–22, featuring live music, carnival rides, arts and crafts, and family fun. From art and music to outdoor adventure and small-town charm, summer in the mountains offers something around every corner.

HIT THE TRAILS THIS SUMMER

Summer in the Blue Ridge Mountains is all about getting outside. The forests are deep green, the mountain streams stay cool, and the longer days make it easy to spend more time exploring. It's one of the best times of year to hit the trails — warm enough for adventure, but still comfortable in the higher elevations.

The Aska Trail System offers easy and moderate hikes through hardwood forests and alongside creeks, making it a great choice for a laid-back summer outing. If you're looking for more of a challenge, the Benton MacKaye Trail and the Appalachian Trail provide steady climbs and sweeping mountain views — especially from Springer Mountain, the southern starting point

of the Appalachian Trail.

Many area trails are dog-friendly, so your four-legged hiking buddy can tag along. **Project Chimps** maintains scenic public trails where visitors can enjoy a peaceful walk in the woods. Summer also brings shaded trails, blooming rhododendron, and plenty of wildlife activity. You might spot deer crossing ahead, hear woodpeckers in the trees, or catch sight of wild turkeys moving through the brush.

Help keep these trails in good shape by following Leave No Trace principles — pack out what you bring in, stay on marked paths, and give wildlife space. Whether you're out for a quick stroll or aiming for a summit, summer is a great excuse to lace up your boots and go.

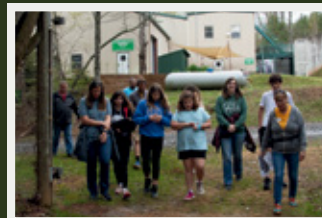

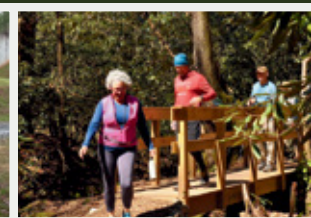
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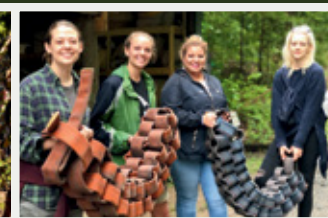

FUN & ADVENTURE

Whether it's inside or outside, there's always something fun and adventurous to do in the Blue Ridge Mountains!

The Blue Ridge Mountains are calling you to enjoy some outdoor adventures. Blue Ridge and the surrounding area provide the opportunity to spend lots of time outside. National forest lands abound, offering short and long waterfall hikes, rugged mountain biking trails, and hikes that tie into the famous Appalachian Trail. You will find camping, fishing, kayaking, white-water rafting, tubing, zip-lining, and horseback riding. Kids can try their luck at gem mining or putt-putt golf. The recreation center has paved paths and outdoor pickleball, tennis, and basketball courts for those who aren't ready to hit the woods, and



there's a seasonal pool and splashpad at the Blue Ridge City Park.

While outdoor adventure is often the lure of the Blue Ridge Mountains, there are plenty of ways to have fun indoors if the weather isn't cooperating or if you just want to enjoy some unique activities offered around town. Spend some time in a museum dedicated to Bigfoot, or play pinball on classic arcade machines while enjoying a cold beer. You can also try your hand at indoor putt-putt, use your powers of deduction in an escape room, or take a ghost tour.

(Fannin County Historical Museum, p. 17) — Discover the stories, artifacts, and local heritage that helped shape the North Georgia mountains. From early settler history to life in the Copper Basin, this museum offers a fascinating look into the people and places that made the area what it is today.



SUMMER ARTS TRADITION ➔

(Butternut Creek Festival, p. 40) — Browse handcrafted artwork, pottery, jewelry, woodwork, and more during this longtime mountain tradition. With artists from across the region, live demonstrations, and a relaxed outdoor setting, it's a perfect way to spend a summer weekend in the mountains.

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FUN IN THE

COPPER BASIN
too great for one state

McCaysville, GA, and Copperhill, TN, provide two states' worth of fun, food, shopping and history — all in one adventure-packed corner of the mountains. Whether you're traveling by road, rail or river, the Copper Basin is a great place to spend the day exploring.

Originally home to the Cherokee, the two rivers here still bear Native American names: Toccoa (meaning "beautiful") and Ocoee ("apricot vines"). The historic steel truss bridge, built in 1911, marks the spot where the gentle-flowing Toccoa becomes the whitewater powerhouse Ocoee as it flows northward from Georgia into Tennessee. It also joins the two cities of McCaysville and Copperhill.

MAKING HISTORY

The locals call this area the **Copper Basin** due to its long history of copper mining. Copper was discovered in 1843 by a gold prospector panning in North Potato Creek. After that, copper ore mining and sulphuric acid production became the primary industries through the late 1980s.

Although mining created a burst of wealth, it came with an environmental cost: Open smelting, timber harvesting and acid rain denuded the surrounding forest for 50 square miles. Following historic restoration efforts by the TVA and Tennessee Copper Company, the Copper Basin has regained much of its natural beauty. Today, it's a source of pride as locals welcome visitors to enjoy new restaurants, retail shops and rivers of fun.

FINDING NEW LIFE

Since 2018, both towns have undergone a dramatic revitalization, and seen an influx of new stores, restaurants, entertainment — and visitors! — as a result. The steel bridge was renovated, and ongoing updates include installing new park benches and streetlights around

the "Blue Line"

town, upgrading landscaping, and adding copper mining artifacts and signage to share the area's history with visitors. Toccoa River Park, a 4-acre park along the river, features exercise equipment, walking paths, picnic pavilions, a playground, dog park and boat launch.

Small businesses are doing their part to draw tourists and locals back to the area as well. For example, an entire city block of McCaysville (between Blue Ridge Drive & Bridge Street) was completely renovated and turned into McCaysville's **Riverwalk Shops** and **TOONEYS Social Club**.

The design of the mall captures the spirit of the Copper Basin's mining history. Inside, you'll find three river-front restaurants and lots of eclectic and unique boutique stores — offering plenty of places to eat, shop or just relax.

RIDE THE RAILS (OR TAKE THE CAR)

If you're riding the **Blue Ridge Scenic Railway**, these twin towns are the "end of the line" — the place where you disembark for a bite to eat

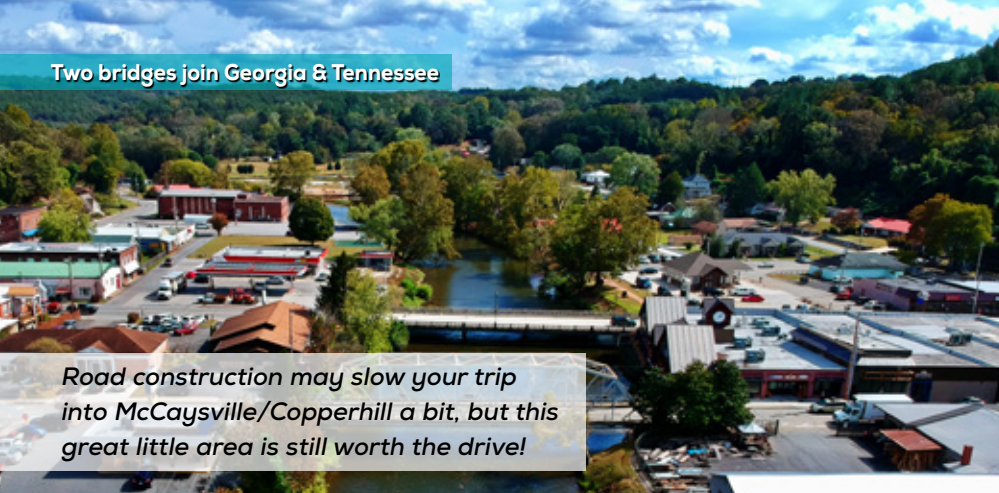

Area Fast Facts

- McCaysville, GA, population = 1,149; Copperhill + Ducktown, TN, population = 904.
- Copperhill & Ducktown were settled around 1843 when copper was discovered in the area. It was mined until the late 1980s.
- Open smelting, timber harvesting and the release of harmful gases destroyed the forests around Copperhill. In 1939, the TVA and the Tennessee Copper Company began a long-term reforestation project to help restore the area.
- Long before the 1850s copper mining boom, the area was home to the Cherokee. The two rivers still bear Native American names: Toccoa (meaning "beautiful") and Ocoee (meaning "apricot vines").
- The Toccoa River flows north from Blue Ridge to McCaysville. When it crosses into Tennessee, it becomes the Ocoee River, known for challenging whitewater rafting rapids.
- The Ocoee Whitewater Center off Hwy. 64 was the site of the 1996 Olympic Summer Games Canoe & Kayak Slalom competition. **Note: The OWC building was destroyed by fire in 2021; however the areas around it are still open to the public.**

and an amble through town and the quaint shops filled with antiques, clothing, jewelry, artwork and gifts. Be sure to check the train's website to learn more about several theme rides planned throughout the year.

Of course, you don't have to ride the train to visit. To explore on your own, just hop in the car and make the quick 15-minute drive from Blue Ridge (10 miles via GA Hwy. 5) or Morganton (11 miles via GA Hwy. 60).

10 REASONS TO VISIT

There are plenty of reasons to make a trip to the Copper Basin, but here are 10 of our favorites:

#1: BLUE LINE SELFIE — Take a selfie as you straddle the blue line and stand in two states at once! The painted blue line runs from the IGA parking lot diagonally across Toccoa Avenue/Ocoee Street, through the middle of restaurants and shops, and across the old steel bridge.

#2: FUN ACTIVITIES — For high-flying adventure, it's hard to beat the [Ocoee Canopy Tour](#), where you can zip, walk and climb through a scenic pine forest. Horseback riding can be found nearby at [Blanche Manor at Blissful Owl Ranch](#), which specializes in trail rides and cowboy adventures. At [The Folk Collaborative](#), you can experience old-timey Appalachia with classes, farm tours, picnics and apple picking.

#3: DELICIOUS DINING — Inside the Riverwalk Shops, you can choose from three dining options, all with covered patio areas: [Burra Burra on the River](#) features craft beer, fine wines and classic American fare; the [Twisted Tomato](#) cooks up amazing pizza in a real wood-fired oven; and [Happy Bear Ice Cream & Treats](#) offers kid-friendly faves like hot dogs and plenty of flavors of ice cream. Across the bridge, stop in the [Rum Cake Lady Cuban Café](#) for the best Cuban sandwiches, coffee and

rum cakes this side of Miami. Right on the state line get your caffeine fix at [Yellowbird Coffee Shop](#) or [Border Brew & Bites](#). And [The Cafe at 32 Toccoa](#) has all-day breakfast and tasty sandwiches for lunch. [State Line BBQ](#) offers some finger-licking cuisine for lunch and dinner.

Step across the state line into Copperhill and get a juicy burger at [The Copper Grill](#); a little further and you will find [El Rio Mexican Restaurant and Cantina](#), which serves old family recipes, ranging from traditional enchiladas to Steak Ranchero. If you want a blend of American and Mexican be sure to check out [Habanero's](#) for some fresh Tex-Mex style food made from scratch. A little further up the road drop by [Hwy 64 GYM](#) to give your taste buds a workout.

#4: UNIQUE SHOPPING — Inside McCaysville's [Riverwalk Shops](#) you'll find a full assortment of fun & trendy stores, including [Afrika Corner](#), [Bea Flair Boutique](#), [Bailey's on Bridge Street](#), [The Pasta Market](#), [Mainstreet Mutt](#), [Copperhill Rock & Mineral](#), [Christmas Is Here](#), [Riverwalk Sweets](#), and [Farfingel's Toy Shop](#), plus a second location of [Blue Ridge Adventure Wear](#).

On Saturdays through October check out the [Twin Cities Market](#) from 9am to 2pm on the historic steel bridge that connects the two cities.

Down the street, you'll want to wander the aisles in [Chooch Oddities & Unique Finds](#), a fun store brimming with one-of-a-kind goods.

On the Tennessee side of the line in Copperhill you'll find a variety of shops, including [Bearfoot in Blue Ridge](#), [Copper-Mine Candle Co.](#), [Mustang Sally Clothing and Jewelry](#), [Toccoa River Outfitters & Fly Shop](#), [Trackside Trading Co.](#), [Wildflower Emporium](#), and [Paradise Beauty Company](#).

#5: BREWERIES & BARS — [Copperhill Brewery](#), [Buck Bald Brewing](#) and [The Waterfront](#) offer high-quality, diverse and exceptional-tasting craft beers in a lively atmosphere. Meanwhile [Bar 21](#) features a wide selection of wine and cocktails in a warm and unique setting.

#6: BEAUTIFUL PARKS — Located on the Toccoa River, [Horseshoe Bend Park](#) is a favorite spot for picnics, fly fishing and relaxing. It's also a popular take-out spot for tubing and kayaking. From May through September, the park hosts "Pickin' in the Park," a gathering of musicians and music-lovers on Thursday evenings.

In downtown McCaysville visit [Toccoa River Park](#), which offers a deck over the river, picnic tables, kids play area, workout area, walking path and dog park. If you're looking for a quick float down the river, put in at Horseshoe Bend Park and take out at Toccoa River Park.

#7: OCOEE WHITEWATER CENTER

— The OWC was constructed to host the 1996 Olympic canoe & kayak competitions. Today, this 4-acre recreation area includes hiking & biking trails, and waterplay areas. (fs.usda.gov)

#8: DUCKTOWN BASIN MUSEUM & MINE

— Tour the historic Burra Burra mine and take a journey through 150 years of copper mining. The museum features audio-visuals, artifacts, photographs and displays. A favorite stop is an old mine elevator, now in use as an observation platform overlooking a collapsed and flooded portion of the mine. (ducktownbasinmuseum.com)

#9: WHITEWATER RAFTING

— Take on the challenge of riding the category III & IV rapids for a

truly unforgettable day on the world-famous Ocoee River. Whitewater rafting on this dam-controlled river happens spring through fall. [RaftOne](#), [Rolling Thunder River Company](#) and [Ocoee Rafting](#) are three of the premier outfitters serving the area.

#10: RELAXATION AND TRANQUILITY

— With its serene natural surroundings and laid-back atmosphere, the Copper Basin provides the perfect setting for relaxation and rejuvenation. Whether you're enjoying a leisurely stroll along a scenic trail or simply soaking in the beauty of the landscape, you'll find plenty of ways to unwind and reconnect with nature.

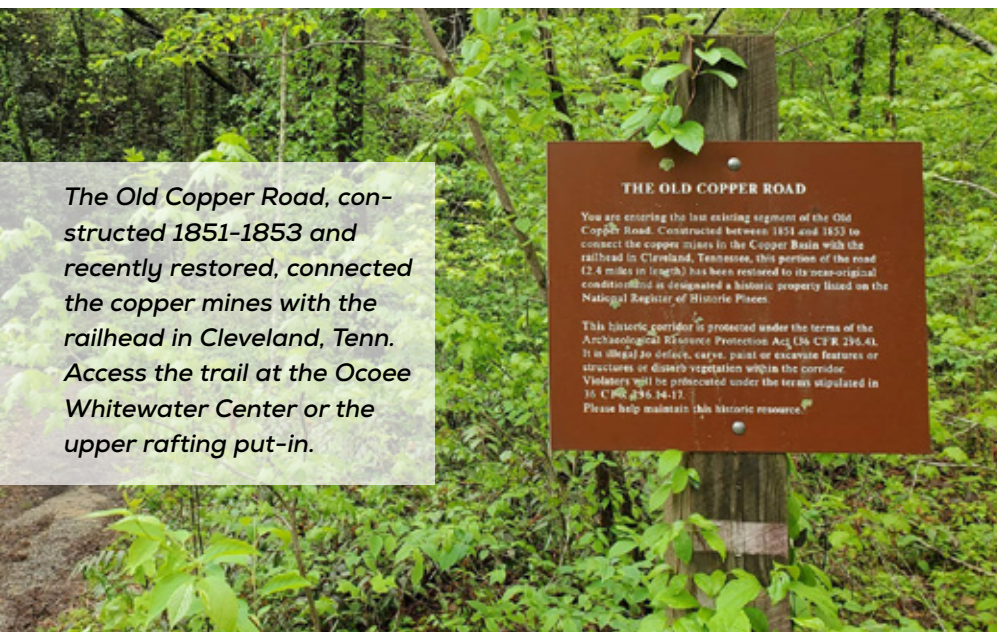
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McCaysville and Copperhill are twin cities situated along the GA/TN state line, where the Toccoa River becomes the Ocoee River, and visitors can stand with one foot in each state.



The Old Copper Road, constructed 1851-1853 and recently restored, connected the copper mines with the railhead in Cleveland, Tenn. Access the trail at the Ocoee Whitewater Center or the upper rafting put-in.

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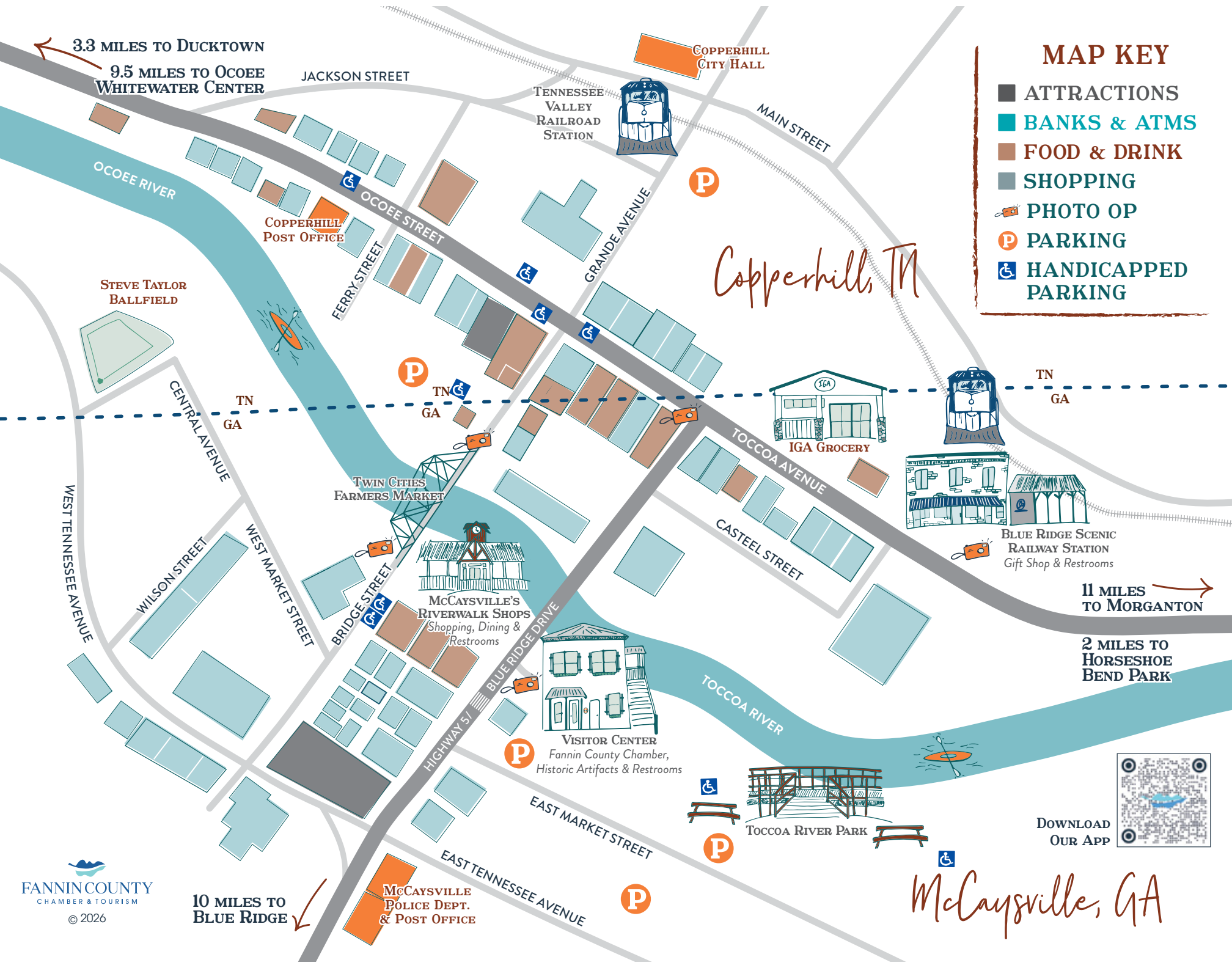

JUST UP

Take a short drive east on Hwy.

When you head east from Blue Ridge on Hwy. 515, you'll discover a whole new world to explore! Whether you spend a few hours or a couple days, you'll find great restaurants, cute shops, friendly people, fun festivals and an abundance of amazing natural attractions.

FIRST STOP: UNION COUNTY

If exploring the great outdoors is your thing, you're headed to the right place. Blairsville-Union County is only 30 minutes away, but home to a variety of great attractions.

Reece Heritage Farm — This historic site explores the life of famed "farmer poet" Byron Herbert Reece with early-1900s buildings and exhibits that capture rural life in Appalachia. There's a poetry walking trail, longer hiking trails, petting farm, pavilion, creek and gift shop/museum. (reecefarm.org)

Vogel State Park — Georgia's second state park was built in the 1930s by the Civilian Conservation Corps. Open year-round, the park features a CCC museum, as well as campsites, cottages, swimming lake, putt-putt golf, hiking trails and a waterfall. (gastateparks.org/vogel)

Helton Creek Falls — Tucked away in a rhododendron grove, this double waterfall is easy to get to. When it's warm, suit up for a shockingly cold dip at the upper falls, which drops about 60 feet into a small swimming area. It's a perfect place to spend the day with the family. (fs.usda.gov)

Walasi-Yi Center — Visit the historic Walasi-Yi Center at Neel Gap, where you can cheer on the thru-hikers while you shop at the outfitters and explore the only place where the 2,192-mile-long Appalachian Trail passes through a man-made structure. (mountaincrossings.com)

CIVILIZATION, TOO

If shopping is more your style, historic downtown Blairsville offers a variety of unique shops and boutiques carrying one-of-a-kind finds and treasures (most stores are pet friendly!). And after a day full of adventure, you'll be ready to sample all the great dining options — from good ol' Southern cooking to exquisitely presented plates.

TOP OF GEORGIA

Brasstown Bald — Rising 4,784 feet above sea level, Brasstown Bald is the highest peak in Georgia. On a clear day, you can see four states plus the Atlanta skyline. Explore the museum, watch a video, and

learn about early Georgia history. You can take a shuttle to the top, or enjoy a short but strenuous hike. (gofindoutdoors.org/sites/brasstown-bald)

Georgia Mountain Fairgrounds — Located along the shores of Lake Chatuge, the Fairgrounds plays host to several popular events — including world-class bluegrass, country, gospel and rock 'n' roll concerts; a Big Green Egg festival; a rodeo; a classic car show; a craft beer & barbecue festival; arts & crafts festivals; and more. There's even on-site camping. (georgiamountainfairgrounds.com)
